

Hi all,

I'm sure at this stage some of you are finding it more difficult to motivate children to do more work. It has been a very difficult time for both children and parents but we are nearly there. As we have covered all areas of the curriculum, just like last week, we are going to concentrate on the last bit of English and Maths.

English: We have completed the reading programme for this year. But please do continue to encourage the children to read during the summer months. Keep on revising sounds and sight words.

- Skills Book B: continue to work through the pages. These pages refer to the stories read.

Maths

- pages 118-121 are revision pages. Try to encourage the children to complete some of these addition problems themselves to see if they are more confident in using the number line or use concrete material if necessary.
- pages 122-123 focus on capacity. We are trying to get the children to observe which container holds the most or least amount. Then there is an experiment page where the children get to estimate how many cups fills a large jug etc and then get to carry out the activity.
- pages 124-125, is a game. Get the children to read the instructions and complete each task.
- pages 126-127 looks at weight. If you cannot compete pg 127, you could just get the children to hold different items such as 1kg flour and 500g of sugar and let them balance them in their hands to feel the difference.
- page 128, the children complete the addition problems and colour in the dinosaur accordingly.
