Here is the plan of work for week 18th of May. I hope you are all well and remember just complete what you can. The most important thing is that the children are reading a bit every day and doing a small bit of maths either orally or written, and playing games and having fun.

English:

- Continue on with the story, 'Bathtime for Rags'. Read up as far as page 22, to the end of the story. Pick out some of the words and see if they can read them, as you will find that the children may read from memory (which is normal at this age) but to ensure that they know the words, mix them up or write some out on a piece of paper.

- The children can read the poem and draw a picture of it.

Maths:

- This week we are looking at money. We are recognizing coins up to 20c. Show the children the different types of coins and get them to explain the differences. Explain that these are the only coins that we have and for example we do not have a 3c coin, we would need a 2c and a 1c to get 3c. Complete pg: 108-111.
- If you have a selection of coins get the children to build different amounts: 4c, 5c, 6c, etc.

SESE:

- This week we are going to look at Minibeasts. Below I have uploaded two Worksheets to complete.

- You can get the children to collect stones and paint them any minibeast that they would like. Below is an example of a ladybird.
